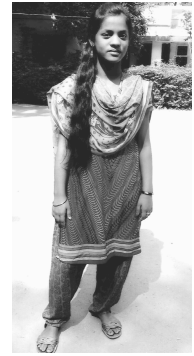
**CONGRATULATIONS TO**

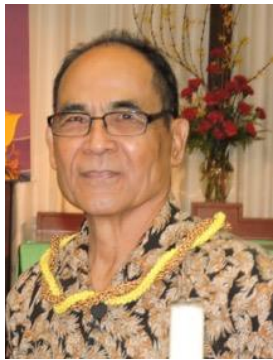
