# SEARCH COMMITTEE UPDATE

The past 22 months have been trying for many as we prepare and wait to hire a new settled pastor. We are grateful to Pastor Jack Belsom for the skills he demonstrated in constructing and completing the transitional process. During that time, we sought to develop a vision for Kailua Christian Church and to begin the work of discerning what God's call is for KCC. This was important in developing KCC's profile which would assist prospective pastors to determine who and what KCC is. That work helped us to inform applicants what characteristics in a pastor are important to the church.

We are now in the formal search process. The Pastoral Selection Committee, comprised of June Tom, Myrtle Terada, Robert St. John, Debbie Glenn, Debbie Fong, Joan Sakaba and Roy Yamauchi (facilitator) have received and reviewed more than 20 pastoral profiles. From this group, six were chosen to be interviewed. The team looked mainly at how the candidates matched those characteristics important to KCC, gleaned also from recent conversations held by the Moderator. Three of the six turned us down immediately. They had access to the KCC Church Profile, which contained a realistic view of our church, our history, our neighborhood, our financials and other pertinent details. (Many hours of research, reflection, writing and editing was conducted by the search team, which now uses their pre-interview work to reflect upon as it attempts to select the best candidate for KCC.) One candidate did not feel he was a good fit; one did not feel our compensation package would support her needs and the third was hired by another church before we could interview him.

We are hopeful that from the remaining three, one stands out as the person we would like to recommend for call to KCC. This requires first, reference checks, negotiations with that individual regarding compensation, more conversation about KCC and what it would take for that person to move to Hawaii, if that is the situation and perhaps even hearing that person preach. Once the team is confident in its recommendation, it will make a recommendation to the Council for their review and considera-Should the Council affirm the search committee's recommendation, a Congregational meeting will be called for approval. That process may include inviting the candidate to preach before vote is taken.

Should none of the three remaining candidates become viable for hire by KCC, the Pastoral Search Committee will return to requesting more profiles from the Hawaii Conference Office, reviewing the profiles, selecting prospective candidates, interviewing them and so on.

The team is prayerfully hopeful that God sends the right person to us. Pastor Jack's words are clear in our minds too, that we will select the person who will best help us discern God's call for KCC. In the interim, the selection team and the Council request your prayers and support as we move through this arduous task of finding a minister for Kailua Christian Church.

Each person has presented a message in their own unique way providing different thoughts and ideas that we can all learn from. What a gift and blessing for KCC and its members and friends. Let's continue to welcome these guests during this interim time. If you feel moved to present your personal testimony, I encourage you to speak with the Worship Leader

I urge us all to continue to pray for patience, love and guidance as the pastoral search process continues. Especially pray for the Pastoral Search Committee members who are dedicating much time and energy to select a candidate for presentation to the congregation. Remember: God answers prayers and, in time, will provide us with a new pastor that will lead us on our ongoing faith journey together as a community of Believers.

#### **DEACON NEWS**


As we are currently a "pastorless" church, let us get the most out of this time of uncertainty to appreci-

Four companies were contacted of which Three quotes were given by 3 different vendors. The trustees made a recommendation of the quote from Abbey Carpet. It will be Hunter Douglas at a price quoted at \$5608.37 all-inclusive, but removal of curtains and hardware are our responsibility. John Sakamoto (photographer), June Tom (worship chairman) and Susan Morita (Trustee) visited the show room where samples were shown and questions were answered to our satisfaction. The trustees are grateful for the interest shown by 2 non-trustees to help confirm our recommendation for the shades. Changing the shades comes at a crucial time as we are concerned of the budget but we are also responsible for the upkeep of our church. As of this date, we have been blessed with 2 donations totaling \$1500.00 which will reduce our cost to \$4108 37

We were happy with the support given by the people who came to hear the details and give approval and support. We will keep you posted to the time frame details as they progress. We hope that we can count on some helpers to physically remove the current fixtures as this helped keep the costs down.
