Finding Life in Our Losses

“Simon, Simon, listen! Satan has demanded to sift all of you like wheat, ³²but I have prayed for you that your own faith may not fail; and you, when once you have turned back, strengthen your brothers.” ³³And he said to him, “Lord, I am ready to go with You to prison and to death!” ³⁴Jesus said, “I tell you, Peter, the cock will not crow this day, until you have denied three times that you know Me.” Luke 22:28-34

The Life of True faith in Christ means...

I. Losses are not final

“Simon, Simon, listen! Satan has

demanded to sift all of you like wheat, ³²but I have prayed for you that your own faith may not fail” Luke 22:31

II. Losses can lead us to lifting others

“and you, when once you have turned

back, strengthen your brothers.” Luke 22:32b

- **How has your losses helped you encourage others? Ex. Kindness, understanding, presence**

III. Losses help us find true faith from our limits
