"Easing What Pains Them" Genesis 45:4-7

"Then Joseph said to his brothers, "Please come [a]closer to me." And they came closer. And he said, "I am your brother Joseph, whom you sold to Egypt. 5 Now do not be grieved or angry with yourselves because you sold me here, for God sent me ahead of you to save lives. 6 For the famine has been in the land these two years, and there are still five years in which there will be neither plowing nor harvesting. 7 So God sent me ahead of you to ensure for you a remnant on the earth, and to keep you alive by a great deliverance.

I. Meeting our mutual hurt with mercy.

"Then Joseph said to his brothers, "Please come [a]closer to me." And they came [b]closer. And he said, "I am your brother Joseph, whom you sold to Egypt. 5 Now do not be grieved or angry with yourselves because you sold me here, for God sent me ahead of you to save lives." Genesis 45:4-5

II. Exchanging our grief for God's greater good.

"But Joseph said to them, "Do not be afraid, for am I in God's place? 20 As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good in order to bring about [a]this present result, to keep many people alive." Genesis 50:19-20

III. Letting kindness conquer contempt.
